Next Student council meeting will be in March.

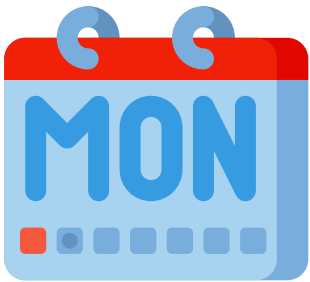




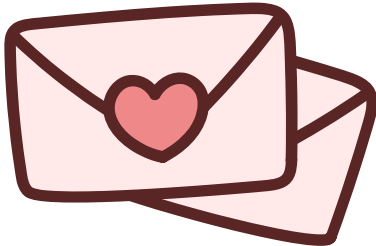
COMING UP THIS TERM!
